Who is Who At Cataract #2?



Worshipful Brother David Kampf

was born in Alexandria, Minnesota and attended grade schools in several states before graduating from High School in Minneapolis. WB Dave received a degree in Electrical Engineering from the University of Minnesota and he began his

business career working for Honeywell and later Alliant Techsystems as an engineer, Engineering Manager and Program Manager. In 1996, Dave founded Wind Ridge Systems, LLC, a technology and business consulting firm headquartered in Minnetonka.

Dave joined Century Lodge #338 in Richfield, Minnesota and was raised a Master Mason in November 1983. He has been a member of Cataract Lodge #2 since its merger with Richfield Lodge #334 and Century Lodge in 2000. He served as Worshipful Master of Cataract Lodge in 2009 and 2010. Since 2011, WB Dave has served Cataract Lodge as the Lodge Treasurer. In March 2014, WB Dave was presented the Hiram Award from Cataract Lodge by Most Worshipful Grand Master David E. Olson.

In 1984, WB Dave joined the Minneapolis Scottish Rite and Zuhrah Shrine, and is very active in ritual degree work at the Scottish Rite. In October 2003, Dave received the Rank and Designation Knight Commander of the Court of Honour from the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite. And in August 2007, he was Coroneted 33° Inspector General Honorary at the Joint Northern Jurisdiction / Southern Jurisdiction Biennial Session of the Scottish Rite in Washington, DC. Illustrious Brother Kampf is also a founding member of the Minneapolis Scottish Rite Consistory Order of the Black Pouch.

In 2005 and 2006, Dave served the Scottish Rite as Master of Kadosh for the Minneapolis Consistory. From 2006 to 2013, Dave served as the Assistant Personal Representative to the Sovereign Grand Inspector General of Scottish Rite Masons in Minnesota for the Minneapolis Valley. In January, 2014, WB Dave was appointed Personal Representative to the SGIG for the Minneapolis Valley. WB David is a member of St. Johns #9 Royal Arch Masons where he serves as High Priest for the year 2015, Minneapolis Council #2 Cryptic Masons, and Zion Commandery #2 Knights Templar in Minneapolis. In 2010, Sir Knight Dave was elected and installed as Eminent Commander of Zion Commandery. In May 2012, PEC Kampf was invested with the rank and title Knight Commander of the Temple by the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar for the United States.

WB Dave is a member of Minnesota Council #111 Allied Masonic Degrees where he served as Sovereign Master in 2011. Companion Sir Knight Kampf has been a member of Minneapolis York Rite College #39 since 2011 and a member of City of Justice Tabernacle Holy Royal Arch Knight Templar Priests since 2012. Dave is also a member of St. Olaf Conclave of the Knights of the Red Cross of Constantine, and Minnesota Council #34 Knight Masons. Sir David joined the Royal Order of Scotland 2014 and is a founding member of Noble Stone Court No. 104 of the Masonic Order of Athelstan. In November 2014, WB Dave was invested with the DeMolay Honorary Legion of Honor.

David and his wife Barbara Wood make their home in Minnetonka. Together, Dave and Barbara enjoy fishing in Voyageurs National Park in northern Minnesota, scuba driving, travel and cooking.
